



PUBLIC MEETING NOTICE

The Connecticut Department of Transportation (CTDOT) will conduct a Virtual Public Information Meeting concerning the New Mix project, CTDOT's program for the planning and implementation of a series of projects aimed at addressing the long-term needs of the Interstate 84 and Route 8 "Mixmaster" interchange in Waterbury.

The New Mix (State Project No. 151-331) will analyze and weigh various rehabilitation and replacement options to develop an actionable plan to modernize and improve the safety and functionality of the interchange. The New Mix will utilize a planning process known as a Planning and Environmental Linkages (PEL) Study. The use of PEL is encouraged by the Federal Highway Administration as it considers environmental, community, and economic goals early in the transportation planning process. The CTDOT may adopt or incorporate Planning Products from this PEL Study into a federal or state environmental review process, pursuant to Title 23 U.S.C. § 168(d)(4).

This public meeting will include an overview of the "Universe of Alternatives" being considered for the long-term future of the Mixmaster interchange. As the New Mix project progresses, these project alternatives will go through three levels of screening to determine the ability of each to meet the project's purpose, needs, goals, and objectives in addition to their expected impacts to the built and natural environment. The New Mix PEL Study is expected to narrow the Universe of Alternatives to a "Reasonable Range of Alternatives" which will be studied further under the processes set out by the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA). The meeting will conclude with a question-and-answer session, at which point attendees will have the opportunity to ask questions and/or offer comments regarding the project.

The meeting will be held virtually via Zoom and will also be recorded. Instructions on how to provide comments and ask questions during the Zoom meeting will be provided at the beginning of the meeting.

Two meeting times will be offered to make it convenient for members of the public to attend. The meeting options are:

- Thursday, September 15, 2022, at 12 noon
- Thursday, September 15, 2022, at 6 p.m.
