The New Mix is an ongoing Connecticut Department of Transportation study that will plan for and implement a series of projects for the long-term reconstruction or replacement of the Interstate-84/Route 8 interchange in Waterbury, commonly referred to as the Mixmaster. The New Mix will also consider improvements to the local roadway network to enhance safety and connectivity for all users.
